- The objectives of the JASS programme are aligned with the wider learning objectives of the Curriculum for Excellence, The Outdoor Challenge, and the National Curriculum, making it easy to run alongside and incorporate existing curricular activities
- JASS is a way of building confidence in young people. It is about challenging yourself to try and achieve. Achievement isn't all about academic qualifications! Achievement looks different for all of us

SIX SIMPLE STEPS

1. Preparation

- Appoint a school 'champion'
- Decide which classes and teachers will participate
- Familiarisation and training

2. Planning

- What level of Award is being attempted
- How are sections being approached consecutively or concurrently?
- Communication to parents

3. Starting Off

- Complete personal profile
- Choosing activities
- Setting objectives

4. Implementation

- Setting aside time
- Planning activities
- Gathering evidence

5. Completion

- Complete evaluation
- Mentor sign off and comments
- Sectional certificate awarded

6. Celebration

- Certificate, Medal and badge
- Award ceremony
